

Following the announcement of July 12, 2021 from the French government, we inform you that the Sanitary Pass is not mandatory if you are only going to the accommodation part.

Wearing a mask and respecting the health protocol in force remain compulsory in hotel-restaurants. From the beginning of August, the Sanitary

Pass will be compulsory for restaurant areas including on the terrace as well as bars and business seminars. For 12-17 year olds, the Health Pass will only apply from September 30, 2021.

What is the Health Pass?

The Health Pass corresponds to the control of your status either from the "Tous Anti-Covid" application, or in PDF format on the phone, or in paper format.

The Health Pass is valid in the following 3 cases:

- A complete vaccination schedule: 7 days after the 2nd injection for the Pfizer, Moderna, Astra Zeneca vaccines; 7 days after the 1st injection for vaccines in people who have already had COVID; 28 days after the 1st injection for the Janssen vaccine;
- Proof of a negative test (PCR or antigen) of less than 48 hours. For long stays, a test carried out every 48 hours is necessary if you wish to access restaurant areas, bars, terraces and business seminars;
- Proof of a positive test (PCR or antigen) attesting to recovery from COVID older than 11 days and less than 6 months.

What are the places or events where the Health Pass will now be required? • **At the hotel: NO.** The Health Pass will not be required if you are only going to the accommodation part. Wearing a mask and complying with health measures remain compulsory;

• **In the breakfast room: YES.** A valid Health Pass will be compulsory to have breakfast in the room;

• **Inside the restaurant, at the bar and on the terrace: YES.** A valid Sanitary Pass will be compulsory to access the restaurant, the bar or to consume on the terrace;
